

VHC is thrilled to announce the opening of **Pooya Aryanpour's** debut solo in India, **'Elysian Fruit – Roaring River.**' The exhibition showcases a collection of paintings and sculptures inspired by the profound intellectual roots of Persian handicraft techniques and cultural symbolism while delving into and referencing the Western tradition of abstract art.

Elysian Fruit – Roaring River previews on **Saturday, 10 February, from 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM at VHC I Vida Heydari Contemporary**. It will run through 10 March 2024. The Artist will be present at the exhibition preview.

POOYA ARYANPOUR – ARTIST STATEMENT

My creative practice draws inspiration from the rich intellectual foundations of Persian handicraft techniques and cultural symbolism while referencing and exploring Western traditions of abstract art.

In my creative practice, I delve into properties of abstraction such that the blending of colour, line, form and content constructs a novel, suspenseful whole. For me, notional shapes and vivid colours can be effortlessly moulded into infinite forms such as living beings, architectural reliefs, plants and even perhaps musical notes. I aim to seize those transient instances in an attempt to solidify the fleetingly perceptible natural forms in the world before they evaporate into the ethereal.

By challenging the philosophical and artistic ideals of finitude and perfection, I make an attempt to deconstruct reality to highlight the inherent gaps in human perception. I believe nothing is ever complete, as reality is in a state of constant flux and is ever evolving. In that vein, I seek to establish meaningful parallels between the natural and the conceptual by dismantling the tangible into its fundamental elements whilst simultaneously reconstructing the same with meticulous care.

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Pooya Aryanpour, born in 1971 in Tehran, Iran, is an artist, art instructor and university lecturer. He studied painting at the Faculty of Art and Architecture, Azad University Tehran, where he obtained his Master's degree in 1999. His work has been extensively exhibited in Iran and overseas at biennials, galleries, art fairs and institutional exhibitions.

In his three-dimensional pieces, Aryanpour combines architectural practices, sculpting and painting inspired by traditional Iranian ornamentation techniques such as mirror work (Ayine-Kari). He has adapted these to his vision through diverse modern approaches and procedures. Using such techniques, Aryanpour often takes the observer beyond the physical boundaries of his sculptural pieces as they create sweeping reflections through a play of light, lines and forms and offer a captivating sensory presence.

Aryanpour lives and works in Tehran, Iran.
